

What To Do If Your Notary Seal Or Stamp Goes Missing:

Notary seals and stamps are enticing marks for thieves, and you must always be sure to safeguard them. Thieves want notary tools because a seal or stamp can be used to produce fraudulent documents. If your notary seal or stamp go missing, it's important to take immediate action.

You Must Report Lost Or Stolen Notary Tools:

Report lost or stolen notary tools to your local police department immediately, and keep a photocopy of the police report. Unless officials know someone has taken your notary tools, you could actually be accused if another person uses them to commit fraud.

The State of Florida requires a lost seal or stamp to be reported to the Department of State in writing. This is **MANDATORY** by state law in Florida.

Florida Statutes Chapter 117 NOTARIES PUBLIC - 117.05 (3c) A notary public whose official seal is lost, stolen, or believed to be in the possession of another person shall immediately notify the Department of State or the Governor in writing.
